# Required English Language Assessment for Non-Native English Speaking Graduate Students

The Graduate English Language Learners Program, in collaboration with the School of Graduate Studies, requires that non-native English speaking graduate students awarded a teaching assistantship take the Versant English Placement Test (VEPT). The VEPT is a computer-based English language assessment that measures proficiency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. The VEPT assigns scores along the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), a globally recognized English proficiency scale, and generates a detailed report.
