**IE@RELI - PALS Refund Policy**

If a student has paid and chooses to withdraw from courses, a refund will be issued by check or applied to credit card from Rutgers University. **It can take four to six weeks for the refund to be issued after the request date.**

\*\*Please note that the \$200 tuition deposit and \$150 Rutgers International Program Facilitation Fee (if applicable) are **not** refundable.

- **Before classes begin**, 100% of tuition and fees, excluding tuition deposit and Rutgers International Program Facilitation Fee, is refundable.
- **During IE@RELI - PALS Add/Drop Period (first week of classes – deadline May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020)**, 50% of tuition fees, excluding tuition deposit and Rutgers International Program Facilitation Fee, is refundable.

*\*\*The Board of Governors of Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey establishes policy, tuition, fee, health insurance, room and board rates for the upcoming academic year during the annual budget meeting in July. PALS adheres to these increases and adjusts its rates and fees accordingly. Rates provided before the annual budget meeting are subject to change.*

### **Program in American Language Studies Deregistration Policy**

The cancellation of a student’s enrollment or registration for any period of time is referred to as deregistration. Deregistration is an administrative action taken when a student fails to fulfill a financial obligation or established administrative deadline while enrolled at the Program in American Language Studies. Examples of financial obligations and/or administrative deadlines include, but are not limited to:

1. Non-payment of tuition, textbook fees, program fees, dormitory fees, rent, meal plans, health insurance premiums or late payment fees
2. Failure to meet an immunization requirement deadline or address immunization non-compliant status
3. Failure to submit a Financial Guarantee form from a scholarship benefactor (ex: SACM)
4. Failure to adhere to registration deadlines established by the Program in American Language Studies

The Director or Assistant Director of the Program in American Language Studies may initiate the deregistration process. When a student is deregistered, the International Student Advisor will notify the student that he/she is not permitted to attend any educational or school related activities, such as: Academic classes, Discovering America Trips, The Club, “WE” Magazine, exams, etc. while deregistered. The course instructors will also be notified. During the period of deregistration, the student will be assigned a grade of zero (0) for missed educational or school related activities, and will accumulate unexcused absences which will affect the student’s visa status. The Program Coordinator will re-register the student once the student satisfies any and all financial or administrative obligations, and pays a re-registration fee of \$50.00.
